Rev. Dr. John Tape is a graduate of Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, IN (1980). He has been a graduate student at Lutheran School of Theology, Chicago; Concordia Seminary, St. Louis; and Washington University, St. Louis. Pastor Tape is theologically evangelical and most comfortable with traditional worship but also has been involved in congregations with contemporary worship. He is outstanding in the area of creativity as a pastor. His personal skills that are very good are tact, cooperation, initiative, leadership, innovation and people skills. As to his pastoral skills, they are outstanding in the area of family ministry and personal witnessing as well as children's ministry, youth ministry, young adult ministry, singles ministry, lay leadership development, preaching content and delivery, teaching ability, conduct of worship, sick/shut-in visitation, outreach visitation and home visitation. Pastor Tape has previously served in an excellent manner as an Interim pastor in the Missouri District. He has worked extensively in the area of Christian media and literature.

Senior High Sunday Morning Bible class will be in Meeting Room #2 with Joellyn Furman.

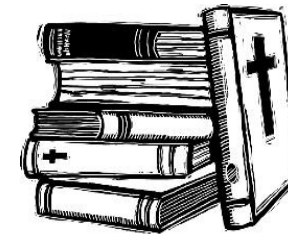
Junior High will meet in the Youth Room downstairs.
